New On-Campus Drop-Off AND Pick-up Beginning Monday, March 6th

We are excited to be able to invite parents on campus for drop-off AND pick-up at the classroom door beginning next week. Parents will enter through our front office door, using a special code just for authorized guardians on your emergency contact list. Please do not share this code with anyone not on your emergency contact list. In addition, for security reasons, please do not hold the front door open when you enter or exit, for other families you do not know. Our classrooms will be closed for drop-off and pick-up at lunch and nap time (1:00-3:00 pm) and for evening pick-up (4:00-5:30 pm). At these times, you can use the code to enter the office and our office staff will assist by getting your child from the classroom, to prevent disruptions. You can continue to sign-in and sign-out on your phone, or on your classroom or office iPad. In efforts to keep our parking lot traffic to a minimum as well, we ask that you keep your drop-off periods brief. Please look for an email this week with a very private Front Door Code. If you have a designated person that drops off or picks up, please share this new process with each person involved We feel this new process will offer better security and protection for our school and bring more community to our SCC Family.. ~
